1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*; the rules established by the National CAL 25 Association; the rules as modified by the Port Huron CAL 25 Association; except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions.

- 1.2 For this regatta the minimum number of crew shall be three (3), the maximum number shall be six (6) including the skipper.

- 1.3 No crew changes, after the first race, will be allowed unless approved by the Race Committee, in writing, prior to a race.

- 1.4 Advertising will be restricted to Category A

2 ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to bona-fide CAL 25 owners and immediate family members such as the owner's wife, son, daughter, brother or sister. Cases of short term ownership do not qualify. The Regatta Committee reserves the right to judge the eligibility of each entry.

- 2.2 The helmsman must be a bona-fide CAL 25 owner or family member, as above.

- 2.3 The yachts and sails must conform to the rules of the National CAL 25 Association, the local CAL 25 Association or as modified by the Regatta Committee. Yachts and sails are subject to inspection at any time during the regatta by the Inspection Committee.

- 2.4 All sail and yacht-measurements must be certified by or approved by the Local CAL 25 Association Measurer.

3.3. **Schedule of Racing:**

It is the intent of the Organizing Authority and the Race Committee to run as many races as practical on Friday, August 15 through Sunday August 17, 2008. No Warning Signal will be made after 1400 on Sunday, August 17. The Harbor Start is scheduled for 0800 on each day of racing.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration,

5 RACING AREA

The racing area is in lower Lake Huron within several miles of the Blue Water International Bridge..

6 COURSES

All Courses will be of the windward-leeward type

7 SCORING

7.1 Each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. One completed race will constitute a series. This changes rule A2.

8 DECISIONS of the JURY

8.1 Decisions of the Jury will be final in accordance with rule 70.4.

9 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

9.1 All yachts shall be afloat before 2000, Thursday, August 14, 2008 and shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the Race Committee.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

10.1 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. The race committee will monitor VHF channel 71 and may broadcast various information to the competitors as a courtesy. Failure of the race committee to make a broadcast, the timing of a broadcast, or the failure of a boat to hear a broadcast shall not be grounds for redress under rule 62.1 (a).

11 PRIZES

11.1 Trophies and flags will be awarded to the overall top 5 yachts in the Regatta
11.2 Daily awards will be presented to the top 5 yachts for each race of the Regatta.
